### **TEMPORARY TENT APPLICATION** Fee: \$150

MINOR/NON-COMMERCIAL & (BETWEEN 120 SF & 400 SF) PER TENT

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR TEMPORARY TENT PERMITS:

- 1. Complete the Temporary Tent Permit Application and submit with the following information a minimum of 30 days prior to tent Installation:
  - a. Electrical Application along with the Underwriters Application must be submitted with this application (If any electrical is being used)
  - b. Plumbing Application must be submitted with this application (If any Plumbing/Gas is being used)
  - c. Fee: \$150.00
  - d. Contractor Information:
    - □ Liability Insurance
    - □ Workers' Compensation Insurance
    - Disability Insurance
- **2.** Once Tent is installed complete a Certificate of Compliance and submit for Inspection **BEFORE USE**. (All forms are on our website <a href="https://www.villageofbronxville.com/building-department">www.villageofbronxville.com/building-department</a>)
  - a. If Electrical was installed you must have the Electrical Inspection completed and certificate attached to Certificate of Completion Form.

Note: All application materials and fees must be submitted together as a complete set. Piecemeal submissions will not be accepted.

#### **INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS**

In accordance with Workers' Compensation Law §57 and §220(8)

#### 3 Separate Insurance Certificates are REQUIRED

- 1. **LIABILITY INSURANCE:** ONLY liability insurance is permitted on the ACORD form.
- 2. For **WORKERS' COMPENSATION INSURANCE**, ONLY the following forms are acceptable:
  - <u>CE-200</u> Certificate of Attestation of Exemption from NYS Workers' Compensations and/or Disability Benefits Coverage
  - <u>C-105.2</u> Certificate of Workers' Compensation Insurance (Note: the State Insurance Fund provides its own version of the form – the <u>U-26.3</u>)
  - SI-12 Certificate of Workers' Compensation Self-Insurance
  - GSI-105.2 Certificate of Participation in Workers' Compensation Group Self-Insurance
- **3.** For **DISABILITY INSURANCE**, <u>ONLY</u> the following forms are acceptable:
  - <u>CE-200</u> Certificate of Attestation of Exemption from NYS Workers' Compensations and/or Disability Benefits Coverage
  - <u>DB-120.1</u> Certificate of Disability Benefits Insurance
  - DB-155 Certificate of Disability Benefits Self-Insurance

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**§BC3103: TEMPORARY STRUCTURES** 

#### §BC3103.1 General.

The provisions of Sections BC3103.1 through BC3103.4 shall apply to structures erected for a period of less than **180** days. Tents and other membrane structures erected for a period of less than **180** days shall comply with the *International Fire Code*. Those erected for a longer period of time shall comply with applicable sections of this code.

#### §BC3103.1.1 Conformance.

Temporary structures and uses shall conform to the structural strength, fire safety, *means of egress,* accessibility, light, ventilation and sanitary requirements of this code as necessary to ensure public health, safety and general welfare.

#### §BC3103.1.2 Permit required.

Temporary structures that cover an area greater than 120 square feet (11.16 m<sup>2</sup>), including connecting areas or spaces with a common *means of egress* or entrance that are used or intended to be used for the gathering together of 10 or more persons, shall not be erected, operated or maintained for any purpose without obtaining a *permit* from the *building official*.

#### §BC3103.2 Construction documents.

A *permit* application and *construction documents* shall be submitted for each installation of a temporary structure. The *construction documents* shall include a site plan indicating the location of the temporary structure and information delineating the *means of egress* and the *occupant load*.

#### §BC3103.3 Location.

Temporary structures shall be located in accordance with the requirements of Table BC602 based on the *fire-resistance rating* of the *exterior walls* for the proposed type of construction.

- a. Load-bearing exterior walls shall also comply with the fire-resistance rating requirements of Table BC601.
- b. See Section BC706.1.1 for party walls.
- c. Open parking garages complying with Section BC406 shall not be required to have a fire-resistance rating.
- d. The fire-resistance rating of an exterior wall is determined based upon the fire separation distance of the exterior wall and the story in which the wall is located.
- e. For special requirements for Group H occupancies, see Section BC415.6.
- f. For special requirements for Group S aircraft hangars, see Section BC412.4.1.
- g. Where Table BC705.8 permits nonbearing exterior walls with unlimited area of unprotected openings, the required fire-resistance rating for the exterior walls is 0 hours.

#### §BC3103.4 Means of egress.

Temporary structures shall conform to the *means of egress* requirements of Chapter BC10 and shall have an *exit access* travel distance of 100 feet (30 480 mm) or less.
