Collection Summary

Title: Bronxville History Center Vertical File

Span Dates: The entire scope of Bronxville's history.

Volume: 14.3 linear feet

Location: Bronxville History Center, Village of Bronxville, at the Bronxville Public Library

Summary: Primarily a collection of newspaper and magazine clippings, reprints, and photocopies, but also including correspondence, especially reference responses of the Bronxville village historians, printed material, and other items. The file is arranged under subject headings such as Architects, Artists, Education, Houses and Buildings, Individuals, Organizations, and Religion.

The Vertical File should be used together with other History Center collections, especially those with a similarly wide range of subject matter, such as the Printed Materials Collection, the Document Collection, and the Photograph Collection. Collections named for organizations (Bronxville Public Library Collection; Bronxville School Collection; Records of the Anne Hutchinson Chapter, Daughters of the American Revolution; Records of the Leonard Morange Post No. 464, American Legion; Village of Bronxville Collection; and others) and for individuals also have a clear connection with similarly named files in the Vertical File.

Access Status: The Vertical File is open for research at the Bronxville History Center.
