**Collection Description:** 

The Papers of Ferris J. Meigs—lumber company executive, son-in-law of William Van Duzer and Sarah Lawrence and long-time resident of Bronxville--are composed primarily of personal correspondence among members of the Meigs family. Many, perhaps most, of the letters in the collection relate to a lengthy international trip which Ferris J. Meigs's parents, Mr. and Mrs. Titus B. Meigs, took in 1901. Titus B. Meigs's letters from the trip were transcribed and bound and given the title *Travel Letters*, *Titus B. Meigs, Jan. 7-Sept. 19, 1901.* Another, smaller and later (1926-1931), cluster of letters is from Lucia Meigs Birnie to her brother, Ferris J. Meigs. A 1918 letter from Ferris J. Miegs to Dudley B. Lawrence is quite different from the other letters in the collection; it relates in detail management problems at the Hotel Gramatan. One of the two photographs in the collection is an important, because rare, depiction of William Van Duzer Lawrence, touring probably somewhere in France.

The Ferris J. Meigs Papers were given by Lucia Stout Andrews, the daughter of Louise Lawrence Meigs and Ferris J. Meigs, to her daughter, Rebecca Stout Underhill, in about 1980. Mrs. Underhill donated them to the Bronxville History Center in 2023.
