1948	Graduated, Bronxville High School
1952	Graduated, Massachusetts Institute of Technology
1954-1956	Served in the US Army
1958-1990	Career with oil, mining, and homebuilding companies
1963	Married (three children)
1990	Retired, moved to Grantham, New Hampshire
1990-	Active in outdoor sports; community volunteer

Collection Description

A scrapbook, photographs, correspondence, handwritten notes, programs, school football schedules, school newspapers, a yearbook (class of 1948), and other documents relating primarily to Conrad Frey's involvement in Bronxville School football and track teams, and his participation in reunions of the class of 1948. The beautifully made scrapbook and some other documents in the collection relate to the Bronxville High School football team's 1947 season, during which it was undefeated and seldom scored upon.
