The **Postcard Collection (1906-c. 1960s)** includes images, often the best images of their subjects in the History Center's collection, of Bronxville's public buildings, such as the two Village Halls (1906 and 1942), the Hotel Gramatan and its surrounding commercial buildings, the Bronxville School buildings of 1906 and 1925-30, the Bronxville Public Library, Lawrence Hospital, Concordia College, the five churches (Reformed, Episcopal, Catholic, Lutheran, Christian Scientist), the two railroad stations (1893 and 1916); and also of apartment buildings, residential streets, and houses (especially those in Lawrence Park); and of scenes in the communities surrounding Bronxville.
