





### **Executive Summary**

- Attractive structure with proven performance / structural integrity
- Safe and appealing dining for customers
- Reduction of 1 parking space (4 down to 3)
- Reduction of seating from 40 to 24
- Rebuilt to be removable for winter storage
- Space entirely within LCB storefront, no blockage of other businesses
- No issues with traffic / congestion

#### Updates From Review with Chief Satriale and James Palmer

## On-site meeting held on March 8 to review plans with focus on safety. Agreements were as follows:

- Structure to be moved up the hill by 10 feet to expand commercial loading zone
- Structure will be moved 10 inches towards the sidewalk to increase the width of the driving lane
- We will maintain cement block at base of structure for protection, will be decorated so as to be attractive as current. We will not use curb stop due to tripping hazard.
- Barrer on street side will be planters with cement blocks. It is understood we are responsible for removing these at end of season, not DPW.


