Update Following April 16 Planning Board Review

- Proposal for 3 parking spaces (8 tables, 24 seats) presented on April 16
- Applicant requested to consider reducing space / # of tables
- Applicant has formally assessed reduced space options, results as follows:

Parking Spaces	Tables	Payback Period
3	8	1.6 yrs
2.67	7	1.9 yrs
2.33	6	2.2 yrs
2	5	2.5 yrs

Update Following April 16 Planning Board Review

- Applicant believes his original proposal for 3 parking spaces is:
 - Consistent with policy guidance from the Bronxville Village
 - Consistent with proposal from Underhill Crossing which was approved
 - No issues with parking, congestion, or blocking other merchants



Please feel free to reach out with any questions. The VB thought this was the most equitable way to address concerns regarding the number of parking spaces required and understand that **every location is slightly unique**.



La Casa Bronxville Request

- Approve original proposal reducing space from 4 parking spaces to 3
- Consistent with Bronxville Village policy guidance:
 - o approximately half seats / at least one parking space reduction
- Treats the two larger on-street dining restaurants in a consistent manner
- Achieves village goal of having attractive viable outdoor dining
- Achieves village goals of reducing congestion on the key streets of concern, increasing parking spaces and making seasonal
- Nothing material is gained by reducing size, financially doesn't work
