I am writing in support of the application for Bacione Pasta Shop. Continued new business development should be encouraged in the village. As indicated in the 2020 comprehensive plan survey, 67% of respondents considered it highly important to both "maintain and improve the mix of retail stores, services and other commercial uses that are geared to the needs of local residents and those in nearby communities" and "maintain the "village" character of the CBD through careful control of land uses, storefronts and signage, adequate building maintenance, and on-going streetscape improvements" (Question 6).
