



ACD BACKGROUND

Advanced Cardiovascular Diagnostics (ACD) is founded by Dr. Perry Frankel, a Board Certified Cardiologist, Lipidologist, and multi-state Diagnostician. HEART ATTACKS

- The Cost of a heart attack can range from \$760,000 to \$1 Million
- For every Heart Attack ACD prevents, patients save up to \$1 Million in healthcare
- This includes direct costs such as hospital admission, doctor and prescription drug fee
- Indirect costs may include loss of productivity and time away from work
- With ACD, the cost of a Stress Echocardiogram to prevent a heart attack is \$300

STROKE

- Following a stroke, in the first year alone, care costs \$81,750; including hospital admission.
- On average, the lifetime cost of a stroke is \$103,576 per person.
- 75% of people are unaware of the symptoms of a stroke, until after one occurs by which point 15 to 30% of survivors become permanently disabled, racking up additional costs.
- With ACD, the cost to prevent a stroke with a Carotid Ultrasound is \$200

ANEURYSMS

- An unruptured aneurysms can cost over \$30,000 per person to treat.
- This cost is then doubled when treating a ruptured aneurysm, for which the morbidity rate is 90%.

- Aneurysms often have no symptoms, until they rupture. ACD testing can both prevent the formation of an aneurysm or detect it early enough to prevent a rupture.
- ACD offer Abdominal Aorta Ultrasounds for \$150.

HYPERTENSION

- Managing hypertension costs individuals between \$740 and \$1,200 annually, however only 54% of people with hypertension have this condition under control.
- Undiagnosed or inadequately treated hypertension costs the US economy \$48.6 billion dollars per year.
- 1 in 3 Americans have high blood pressure which is linked to almost 1,000 deaths each day.
- High blood pressure is associated with 69% of heart attacks, 74% of heart failure, and 77% of strokes.
- With ACD, high blood pressure which risks damaging the patient's heart can be identified by an
- EKG test, which costs \$35.
- ACD also provides blood pressure tests, which detect hypertension, for \$75.

ECHOCARDIOGRAM

An echocardiogram is a non-invasive ultrasound test that evaluates the structures of the heart, as well as the direction of blood flow within it.

CAROTID DOPPLER

75% of patients that suffer a stroke do not know they have a carotid blockage. The carotid doppler can determine if you are at risk of a stroke.

LOWER EXTREMITY DOPPLER

A Doppler ultrasound exam measures blood flow through your arteries and veins.

TRANSCRANIAL DOPPLER

A Transcranial Doppler ultrasound measures the velocity of blood flow through the brain's blood vessels by measuring the echoes of ultrasound waves moving through the cranium.

STRESS ECHOCARDIOGRAMS

Heart disease is the number one cause of death in America. A stress echocardiogram test can help determine if you are at risk.

ABDOMINAL AORTIC ANEURYSM ULTRASOUND

Two-thirds of patients that have ruptured aortic aneurysms are unaware that they have one. An ultrasound can determine if you have an aneurysm.

PULMONARY FUNCTION TESTS

Pulmonary function tests (PFTs) are a group of tests that measure how well your lungs work.
