

Additionally, the Village hosts a community cleanup in April to clean downtown. Together, both of these activities help the public to understand the human impact on the Bronx River Corridor and offer opportunities to keep it clean.

On average, between 10 - 30 individuals participate in these events. Furthermore, residents make use of related materials provided by the Village to further educate themselves on proper storm water management.

Furthermore, the Village has retained contractors to assist with storm water cleanouts when DPW equipment is unable to address themselves. Illegal connections and/or illegal discharge into our storm water system require homeowner to make the necessary repairs

The Village actively makes repairs and improvements to our storm water system as well as schedule routine clean outs of storm water catch basins .
