VILLAGE OF BRONXVILLE WESTCHESTER COUNTY, NEW YORK EXISTING STORMWATER OUTFALL CHANNEL STABILIZATION PROJECT (No. VA 2022-04)

NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Sealed bids will be received at the Office of the Village Clerk, Village of Bronxville, 200 Pondfield Road, Bronxville, New York 10708, until 11:00 A.M. on August 9, 2022 immediately after which the bids will be opened publicly and read.

The work under this Contract comprises the furnishing of all tools, equipment, materials and labor for the Existing Stormwater Outfall Channel Stabilization Project, VA 2022-04, located in the Village of Bronxville, New York, complete, in place and ready for use in accordance with the design plan(s) Contract Documents prepared by J. Robert Folchetti & Associates, L.L.C and the scope of work summarized herein.

The principal features of the Work to be performed include: construction of a cast-in-place (C.I.P.) concrete cutoff wall along the face of an concrete wing wall; removal of existing stone rip rap and replacement with NYSDOT "Heavy Stone Fill" from existing wingwall to pedestrian bridge (± 90 cubic yards); removal of existing filter fabric installed beneath rip rap and replacement with heavy duty woven geotextile; removal of deposited sediment and stone rip rap from beneath the pedestrian bridge to re-establish original channel grades; re-grading of existing stone rip and removal of deposited sediment from the channel downstream of the bridge for a distance of approximately ± 75 ft to re-establish original channel grades; hand-raking of existing pea gravel walkway material on the existing pedestrian bridge and placement of a 4 inch layer of item #4 (NYSDOT 304.02 sub-base) material over the pea gravel walkway; removal and off-site disposal of existing vegetation from the existing channel including 5' wide area to the channel and wingwall; installation and removal of 3" stone tracking pad ($\pm 10'$ x $\pm 40'$); installation and removal of silt fencing; installation and removal of orange mesh type job safety fence around job site; and mobilization/de-mobilization of equipment and machines; and miscellaneous cleanup work required to complete the project. A design drawing of the proposed C.I.P. concrete cutoff wall is available upon request from the Village Administrator's office along with Project Record drawings (for reference only) of the existing stormwater outfall channel. The Work included herein shall be completed at the site of the existing stormwater outfall channel located adjacent to Palumbo Place near the intersection of Gramatan in the Village of Bronxville.

The foregoing is a general description only and shall not be construed as a complete description of the Work to be performed for this Project.

One Bid will be received. Bids shall be on a lump sum basis.

A mandatory pre-bid conference will be held at 10:00 AM on August 4, 2022, at the Village Hall, 200 Pondfield Road, Bronxville, New York 10708. The purpose of the pre-bid

conference is to afford the prospective Bidders and interested parties an opportunity to raise questions pertaining to the project scope of work and for the OWNER or its representatives to clarify such questions.

Contract time of completion will be thirty (30) consecutive calendar days from the Notice to Proceed date as specified by OWNER at the pre-bid conference.

Each bid shall be accompanied by a Bid Bond, or Certified Check accompanied by a Certificate of Surety, the coverage of which as specified by OWNER at the pre-bid conference.

This project is subject to the provisions of Article 5-A of the General Municipal Law of the State of New York and certificates required thereunder shall be available for public inspection at the office of the Village Clerk, Village of Bronxville, New York.

For any reason whatsoever, or for no reason, the Village reserves the right to waive any informalities in the bids or to reject any and all bids. No bidder may withdraw their bid except by written request submitted at least twenty-four hours before the time of opening or until the lapse of 45 days after the actual opening thereof.

The Village is exempt from payment of sales and compensating use taxes of the State of New York and of Cities and Counties on all materials to be incorporated into the Work. These taxes shall not be included in the Bid.

The Village will furnish the required certificates of tax exemption to the CONTRACTOR for use in the purchase of supplies and materials to be incorporated into the Work.

The Village's exemption does not apply to construction tools, machinery, equipment or other property purchased by or leased by the CONTRACTOR, or to supplies or materials not incorporated into the Work.

Non-Discrimination in Employment:

It is the policy of the Village that their Contractors shall comply with all Federal, State, and local law, policy orders, rules and regulations which prohibit unlawful discrimination against any employee or applicant for employment because of race creed, color, or national origin, and will take affirmative action to insure that they are afforded equal employment opportunities without discrimination because of race, creed, color or national origin.
